

Alphabetical Listing of Those Buried in the James City Chapel Cemetery

If additional information is available regarding any listing, the information is shown just below the name box for the individual. The source(s) for the information appearing is identified within the comments. Any reference to “(FG Note says...)” refers to information from the findagrave.com website that takes information from family members and friends about those buried in cemeteries. A copy of that list is in the Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives Book 2, B2-1A.
