On Page 73, a note says that Kendall had been a commercial fisherman, but settled in Toano and farmed in Norge and at Holly Springs Farm with his brother-in-law, O. B. Dryden. Kendall and Lura lived on the Holly Springs Farm. Page 89, shows him as buried at James City Chapel Cemetery. (FG Note also says that the middle initial "L." was for Latrove, and that his birth and death dates were: b. 4/14/1895 and d. 11/13/1939.) The obituaries for Kendall L. Fitchett and his wife Lura Marston Fitchett are in the Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives Book 2, B2-26R.
