**Ella Moore Wilkinson** joined Mount Vernon Methodist Church August 8, 1914, but, she was listed as Ella Moore. See Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives Book 3, B3-26. The 1930 U.S. Census, (copy is in the Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives Book 2, B2-26F), shows Ella Moore Wilkinson married to Dandridge Marston Wilkinson, and living in Newport News, VA. However, the obituary for Ella Moore Wilkinson listed her husband as Benjamin. It is unknown if Benjamin was a second husband for Ella. A copy of the Daily Press Obituary dated October 31, 1958; Page 41 is located in the Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives, Book 2, B2-26E. The Membership Register Book for Mount Vernon Church shows Benjamin Wilkinson as a member on September 30, 1887, Dandridge Wilkinson as a member on July 26, 1888, and Ella Moore Wilkinson as a member on August 8, 1914. According the Wilkinson Family Chart, Dandridge and Benjamin were brothers and the sons of Cary Wilkinson and Henrietta Marston Wilkinson.

She then joined Mount Vernon Methodist Church on September 30, 1887. See the Mount Vernon UMC Church Archives Book 3, B3-26. Mentioned in Marston's of Virginia, 1637-1983 by Robert Busby, Page 69, as being Henrietta Marston, and on Page 89, as buried at James City Chapel Cemetery. Her parents, listed on Page 66 of the "Marston" book, were Dandridge Watkins Marston and his first wife, Ann Eliza Morris Marston.
